The price includes bed and full board, visits, participation in conferences, nautical and beach sports, excursions, tickets for festivals, museums, centres and tennis course.

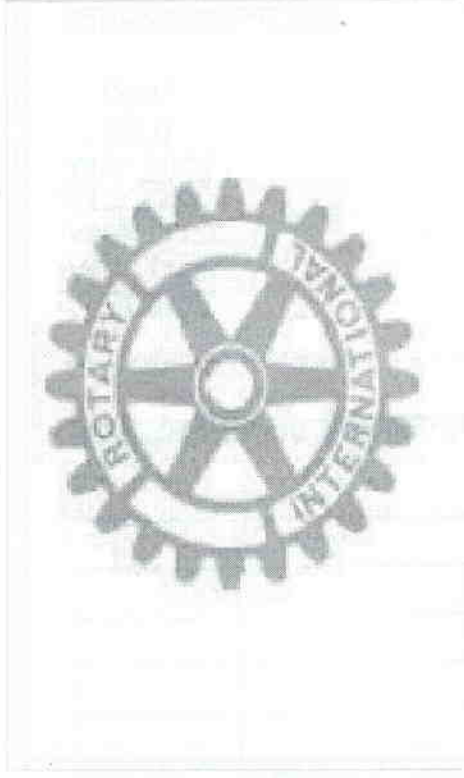
